EVERYONE LOVES A CHEEKY HARE!

In this workshop you will learn to Reverse Hand Applique. I will provide lovely needles and threads which will make your stitching successful even if you've never appliqued before!

A fun, calm day of creating and stitching among friends...please have a look below at some of the Hares created in previous workshops...

But be warned...It seems you cannot make just one!!!

First of all look for a fabric that will provide an interesting setting for your Hare (s)... Is it in a forest? In a copse of trees? In space? This piece needs to be about 20" x 40"

Then consider the hare itself...is it snowy white? A warm, natural brown or perhaps a fantasy hare?

Each large hare is 12" x 22" and each small hare is 6" x 12"....

you have lots of room on your background so consider if you will want 1,2 or 3 hares - large or small? Maybe a family?

If you are unsure bring lots of choices and we can create together on the day!

One metre of Freezer Paper

Erasable fabric marking pen NOT FRIXON PENS! They are dangerous on fabric and don't always vanish permanently.

Your best, cut to the point, small embroidery scissors. Kai, Davo, Karen K. Buckley and Gingher all make excellent ones.

Your favourite Sharp needle.

A 50 or 60 weight cotton thread to match your background fabric.
