Transversions with Jan Hassard



This is a linear pattern consisting of four colours with five fabrics shaded light to dark within each colour range. I have used blue, pink, yellow-orange and green.

The cutting is the same for each colour and fabrics are numbered 1-5, 1 for the lightest and 5 for the darkest. You will need one strip from each fabric as below. All strips will be 40" wide. If using fat quarters two strips will be fine. So don't bother to join them.

1st light strip 2 7/8" x 40"
2nd strip 2 7/8" x 40"
3rd strip 2 1/2" x 40"
4th strip 2 1/2" x 40"
5th strip 2 1/2" x 40"

Plus a strip of 5th fabric 2 7/8" x 40"

1 metre of background fabric

The background is important in this quilt. I have used Moda Grunge in grey so choose a colour which will compliment your other colours and make an impact – or be safe and use black!

Requirements above will make a small quilt or wall hanging 32" x 46" long. Should you want to make it larger I suggest you double up the fabrics.

Rotary cutting equipment
Sewing machine
Usual sewing equipment with threads and bobbins
Camera or phone/tablet
Old sheet to pin work to
