JAPANESE INSPIRATIONS with Pat Archibald
Messing around with Markals Japanese Style

Pat will introduce us to different ways of working with Markal Paintsticks and then we will move onto working on a project so that you can take home something that will be almost finished.

Using one or two beautiful Japanese family crests we will use Markal paint sticks and simple stencils to transfer the designs to fabric. We will add a narrow border and binding and finish with some quilting.

Requirements

- Some scrap fabric to try out different painting techniques and masking tape
- Main fabric 10" x 15", plain or marbled in a colour of your choice
- A few 5" squares of co-ordinating fabrics for a narrow asymmetrical border and one strip 1 1/4" x 15" for a narrow border
- 16" x 16" of backing fabric and cotton wadding (Warm and Natural) or similar
- Thread to match/tone with your fabric plus metallic threads (gold/copper/silver)
- 2.5m of 1" wide black bias for binding the quilt or fabric to make a self binding – you may not get to this stage in the class
- 2m of narrow cord or knitting yarn to tone with your fabric
- Five 8" squares of freezer paper
- 505 basting spray
- Small sharp paper scissors or craft knife, pencil
- Baking parchment, kitchen towel, painting shirt/apron, baby wipes
- Sewing machine, instruction book and attachments, including walking foot, 1/4" foot and cording foot if you have one.
- No.12 Jeans Stitch sewing machine needles,
- No.12 Metallic sewing machine needles,
- Rotary cutter, mat and ruler, small sharp paper scissors or craft knife, pencil
- Plastic bag for trimmings

There will be a small kit fee of £3 for the use of the oil sticks and stencil brushes.
