### Life's a bleach discharging workshop with Mary McIntosh



1/2 metre black cotton fabric (Mary can provide for £4 if pre-ordered)

1/2 metre black linen (Mary can provide for £6 if pre-ordered)

Any stamps, stencils, rubbing boards, or thermofax screens you may wish to use

An old cloth sheet, duvet cover or similar to use as a drop cloth

Glass or plastic headed pins

An old steam iron\*\* if you have one (NOT the one you use for clean work)

Heat gun or hairdryer\*

Pack baby wipes

Kitchen roll

Roll of masking tape

Vinyl or latex gloves

An apron

Mask

Wear old clothes and shoes

Please note that this technique can be quite smelly and may not be suitable for those with breathing problems.

I will provide a padded surface, all the discharge pastes, bleach, fabric paints, brushes, stamps, stencils, freezer paper, screens, squeegees, craft knives, cutting boards, rulers, masking tape, extension cables, heat guns\* and old irons\*\* and other equipment for a materials charge of £6 payable at the workshop.

I will also bring extra black cotton (£10 per metre) black linen (£12pm), and cotton velvet (£12pm) to try if you wish.
