

Sardines Workshop zoom

Students will learn

How to make a pattern from a photograph.

How to appliqué the design so that it is exactly the same as the pattern.

How to add paint to give a 3 dimensional feel to the panel / wall hanging

How to carry out the stitching and binding.

The pattern will need to be printed at home in black and white. This will be sent before the class and is available for this class and should not be forwarded to anyone not on the class,

The panel is made using 100% cotton fabrics. Only small amounts of fabric are needed for the applique and can be whatever colours you choose

As the pattern is print at home it can be any size however i would recommend a size of approx 18" x 25"

Requirements

Grey or cream fabric background fabric approx 18" x 25"

An assortment of 100% cotton patterned fabrics – approx 15 different pieces of fabric each 12" x 4"

White fabric for the edge of the tray eg long quarter

Small pieces of white and black fabric for the eyes

1m Heat n Bond or Bondaweb

Baking parchment

Iron, ironing board

Pencil

Small scissors (4" are best for cutting small pieces)

Iridescent medium - only a small amount is needed. Silver paint could be used instead of iridescent medium

Inktense crayons or watered down grey or black acrylic paint

Wadding size as above

Backing fabric size as above

Sewing machine - quilting thread

Masking tape or a couple of pins

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
